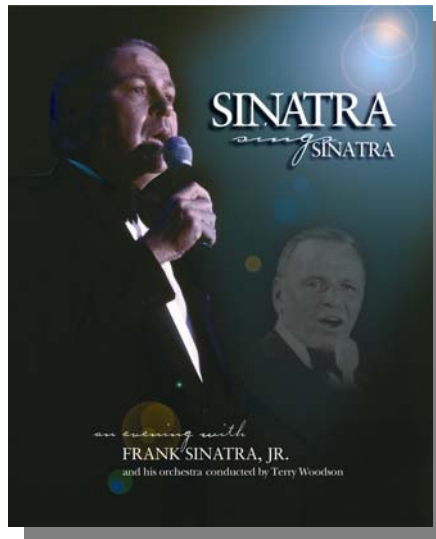

Sinatra Sings Sinatra at Wildhorse Resort & Casino



Pendleton - One of the most interesting and skilled pop vocalists of the era, Frank Sinatra, Jr. will be performing at Wildhorse Resort & Casino on October 16 at 7:00 pm.

Frank Sinatra Sr. has been called the defining voice of the 20th Century. For over five decades his performances were the apex of pop music. His renditions of songs such as I've Got The World On A String, Night And Day, The Lonesome Road, Three Coins In The Fountain, and of course the incomparable My Way make it difficult, if not impossible, for any other singer to include them in their repertoire.

The exception to this is Frank Sinatra, Jr. For many years Frank Jr. worked as his father's music director absorbing the nuances of his father's timing, expressions, stage presence and delivery of each song. In addition he carries within his genes the essence of his father's vocal timbre, an element so crucial when rendering mini-versions of Senior's best songs.



While his big-band shows are marked warmth and enthusiasm, his performances are touted as educational as they are entertaining (by the late 1990's, Frank Jr. was one of the few singers left that actually toured with a full big-band). And his reputation as a considerable musical talent has deepened. Especially with the release of *As I Remember It*. On this album, as in his live performances, Frank Sinatra Jr. tells the story of the Sinatra Legend through careful, thoughtful narration, and perfectly rendered mini-versions of Senior's best songs. Frank Sinatra Jr. is every bit as compelling a personality as his father was, but in a completely different way--and the peculiarity and genius of both men come across in his live performances.

Frank Sinatra Jr. will be featured at Wildhorse Resort & Casino on October 16, singing with his orchestra conducted Terry Woodson, in a performance that will concentrate mainly on paying musical tribute to his legendary father. While easily the best pop vocalist working today in his own right, it is the nostalgia for his father's immortal work that ensures that there will always be a packed house whenever Frank Jr. takes the stage.
