Topics include: The Land, Federal Indian Policies, and Traditions that Bind.

Nov. 15: *Saturday Free Film Festival at 1 and 6 pm.*

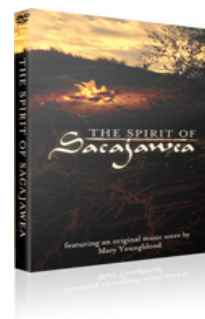
