The Western States Regional Sheep Dog Finals
at Wildhorse Resort & Casino October 3-5, 2008.

The Top 50 handler-Border Collie teams from eight Western States will compete October 3-5 in the Western States Regional Sheepdog Championship near Tamástslíkt Cultural Institute, at the Wildhorse Resort & Casino.

The Course includes gathering, driving, sorting and penning sheep and will be held October 3, 4, and 5, 2008. Friday and Saturday will be the preliminary rounds, and on Sunday the best, most consistent handler-dog teams that week will advance to the double-lift Final on Sunday.

The Finals will be conducted on the grounds of Wildhorse Resort and Casino on the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation five miles east of Pendleton, Oregon, right off of I-84.

Admission is \$3 per adult, \$5 per family and \$10 for families for entire three-day event. Food is available for purchase on-site.

Judge is Scott Glen of Alberta. Scott won first and second place in the 2004 North America Championship and was reserve champion in 2001.
